Dine & Discover - Register your business

Eligible dining, arts and tourism businesses across the state can **now register** to take part in the NSW Government's major economic stimulus program, Dine & Discover NSW.

With every NSW resident aged 18 and over eligible for four \$25 vouchers worth \$100 in total: two \$25 vouchers for eating in at restaurants, cafes, bars, pubs and clubs from Monday to Thursday, and two \$25 vouchers for entertainment and recreation including cultural institutions, live music, and arts venues, available 7 days a week (both streams exclude public holidays), and with vouchers only able to be redeemed with participating business, it makes sense to register early in preparation for the program going live in coming months.

The <u>Service NSW mobile app</u> is already available for participating businesses, so they can scan and track voucher usage over the life of the program.

NSW Visitor Economy Strategy

The NSW government have recently released their Visitor Economy Strategy 2030, providing all industries involved in tourism to recover from the impact of drought, bushfires and COVID-19 and to grow into the future.

The strategy states that Regional NSW will be the future to contributing to recovery with domestic markets to be the primary focus. Making sure that the Macleay Valley Coast is in the best position to strengthen and grow our tourism industry and economy with the support of the NSW Government.

\$800,000 funding program opens to support Aboriginal Languages in NSW

Applications are now open for Aboriginal communities across NSW, thanks to a NSW Government funding program that is designed to support projects that reawaken, grow, nurture, promote and raise awareness of Aboriginal languages.

The Aboriginal Languages Community Investments Program 2021 is an open round grants program offering a total of \$800,000 across three categories to support different project aims:

- Reawaken (supports projects that encourage the development of new or emerging language activities) – up to \$20,000
- Grow (supports existing projects to expand and develop the capacity of groups or organisations) – up to \$50,000
- Nurture (provides support to build the strategic capacity of more established groups or organisations) – up to \$90,000
