Kempsey Waste Management Centre landill operational hours from Monday to Friday are 7:30am to $3: 30 \mathrm{pm}$ and Saturday is 9am to 2:30pm (landfill tipping face), to allow for daily cover activities as per EPA landfill requirements. The landfill tipping face is closed on Sundays.

Kempsey Waste Management Centre asbestos bookings require 24 hours notice, and all asbestos disposal is strictly between 8am to 3 pm . Asbestos bookings maybe cancelled by Kempsey Waste Management Centre staff due to unsafe or wet weather conditions for safe unload activities.

Transfer Stations do not accept commercial waste, industrial waste, or construction and demolition waste. All commercial, industrial, construction and demolition waste loads must be delivered to the Kempsey Waste Management Centre.

Bellbrook, South West Rocks \& Stuarts Point Waste Transfer Stations do not operate on Public Holidays.

Note 1: Not for profit organisations are included in the Event Application process and are required to lodge an Application Form and pay the appropriate fees for their event. Not for profit or community organisations may request an exemption from the hire fees by making application 6 weeks prior to the event.
Note 2: Regular markets require Development Approval and are not included in this category.
Note 3: Some events or commercial activities may require a Crown Lands licence or a Native Title Assessment, which may attract an additional fee.
