


Beware of wild dog attacks

North Coast Local Land Services has received five reports of wild dogs attacking domestic dogs this year.

Most attacks on domestic dogs are fatal due to the severity of injuries and there are steps you can take to reduce the risk.

North Coast Tick Fever

The first case of tick fever in NSW this year has been identified on the North Coast. Tick fever and cattle tick are notifiable under NSW biosecurity legislation. If you find sick or dead cattle, or suspect tick fever, immediately contact your LLS District Vet or call the Emergency Animal Disease Hotline, 1800 675 888.
