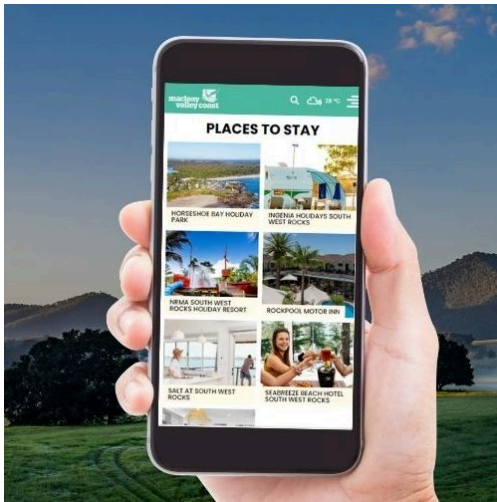
Applications open for Regional Events Fund
