## **OBJECTIVES**

To set Building Alignments.

## STATEMENT

That building alignments be set for existing subdivisions as follows:

## a) Residential Land Zones

- 1 A five (5) metre building alignment from the boundary will be in place for all residential land zones in the Shire excluding:
  - 1.1 A building alignment for a side boundary will be subject to consideration by Council for corner allotments.

#### b) Commercial or Business Land Zones

- 2 Buildings are permitted to occupy the whole of the allotment if used for the purpose of carrying out a commercial or business activity in commercial or business land zones excluding:
  - 2.1 A building alignment will apply for the following locations:
    - 2.1.1 South Street fifteen (15) metres
    - 2.1.2 Akubra Place six (6) metres
    - 2.1.3 Woolford Crescent four (4) metres
    - 2.1.4 Nance Road twelve (12) metres

## c) Industrial Land Zones

- 3 A six (6) metre building alignment from the boundary will be in place for all industrial land zones in the Shire excluding:
  - 3.1 A building alignment for a side boundary in the South West Rocks Light Industrial Estate may be varied by applications and subsequent approval by Council.

## d) Rural Land Zones

- 4 An eighteen (18) metre building alignment from the boundary will be in place for all rural land zones in the Shire (subject to Council's Flood Plain Management Strategy Policy) excluding:
  - 4.1 The provision of the Kempsey Local Environmental Plan (KLEP) 1987 will apply to rural land zones fronting main roads.
  - 4.2 A building alignment will apply to the following locations:
    - 4.2.1 Sandstock Road twelve (12) metres

## e) General Conditions

5.1 Open verandas may be permitted to encroach to within one point five (1.5) metres of the boundary subject to development approval.

## VARIATION

Council reserves the right to review, vary or revoke this procedure which will be reviewed periodically to ensure it is relevant and appropriate.
