Community sharps bins are provided free for residents and visitors to safely dispose of containers of needles, syringes, finger prickers and other health-related sharp items from home.

Never drop sharps on the ground. Never put sharps in household waste (red), recycling (yellow) or organics (green) bins, or in public litter bins.
